

Data Collection Worksheet

Please Note: The Data Collection Worksheet (DCW) is a tool to aid integration of a PhenX protocol into a study. The PhenX DCW is not designed to be a data collection instrument. Investigators will need to decide the best way to collect data for the PhenX protocol in their study. Variables captured in the DCW, along with variable names and unique PhenX variable identifiers, are included in the PhenX Data Dictionary (DD) files.

Immediate Recall

The examiner reads the respondent a short (4-5 lines) story and then asks them to recall details about the story. If the respondent is unable to recall any details or after they have finished providing details, the examiner prompts them to determine if they can recall any additional information.

Delayed Recall

After a predetermined amount of time, the examiner asks the respondent to remember any details they can recall about the story. If the respondent is unable to recall any details or after they have finished providing details, the examiner prompts them to determine if they can recall any additional information. After all details are obtained, the respondent is asked multiple choice questions about the story content.
