

Data Collection Worksheet

Please Note: The Data Collection Worksheet (DCW) is a tool to aid integration of a PhenX protocol into a study. The PhenX DCW is not designed to be a data collection instrument. Investigators will need to decide the best way to collect data for the PhenX protocol in their study. Variables captured in the DCW, along with variable names and unique PhenX variable identifiers, are included in the PhenX Data Dictionary (DD) files.

- 1. At present, how long after waking do you wait before having your first cigarette?
 - 1 [] Within 5 minutes [3 points]
 - 2 [] 6-30 minutes [2 points]
 - 3 [] 31-60 minutes [1 point]
 - 4 [] over 60 minutes [0 points]
- 2. How many cigarettes per day do/did you smoke?
 - 1 [] 10 or less [0 points]
 - 2 [] 11-20 [1 point]
 - 3 [] 21-30 [2 points]
 - 4 [] 30 or more [3 points]

Note on how to score the results:

- A six-point scale is calculated from the time to first cigarette after waking (3, 2, 1, or 0 points) and number of cigarettes smoked per day (0, 1, 2, or 3 points).
- Sum the points for each round of 2 questions asked.
- Nicotine dependence is categorized into a three-category variable: low (0-1), medium (2-4), and high (5-6).
