Sexual Behaviors

Physical sex is sex that happens in person:

Vaginal sex is when a man puts his penis inside a woman's vagina.

Oral sex is when you or your partner puts your mouth on the other's genitals (vagina or penis).

Anal sex is when a man puts his penis in another person's butt.

Virtual sex is sexual behavior that can happen over the phone, video, or social media: this could be people talking about, video chatting, or texting sexual content to each other. It is also called <u>phone sex</u>, <u>sexting</u>, <u>or video sex</u>.
